Take a piece of 20-gauge wire approximately 50 centimeters long. Thread on a single silver 2mm seed bead and wrap it around the center of the pendant base, securing it with a simple overhand knot. Repeat this process, adding seed beads at regular intervals around the base.

5. Add the Pendant to the Chain
