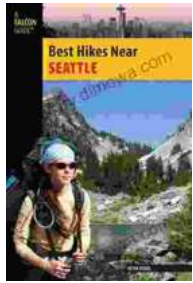

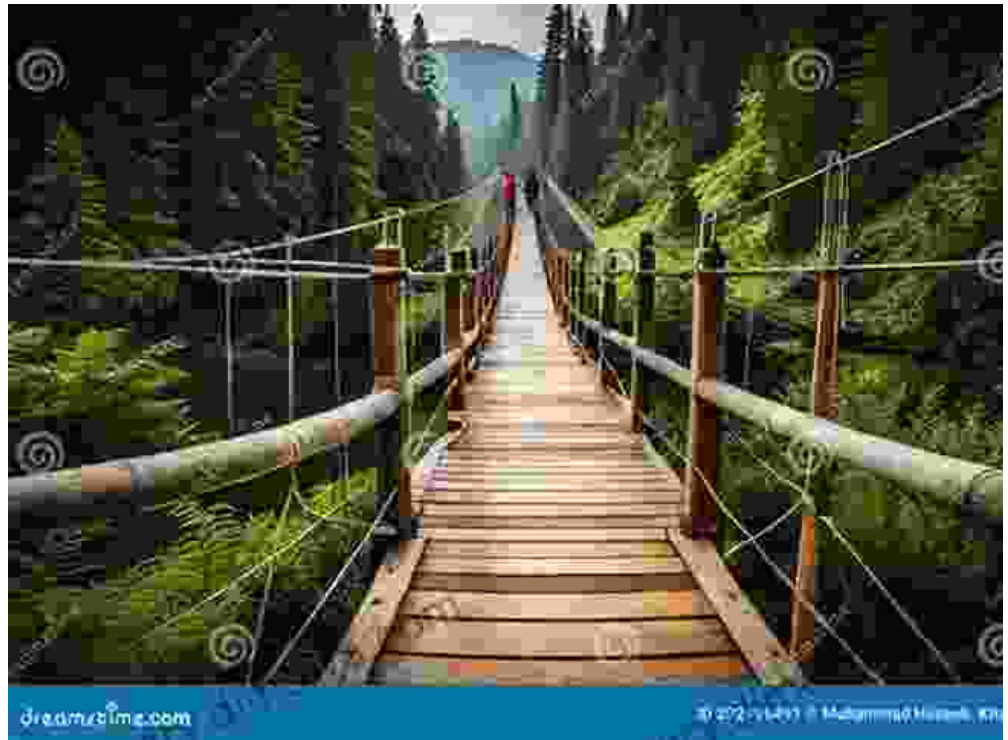


Mount Si via Iron Horse Trail
